10th Birthday Celebrations

Anam Cara Colac was formerly commissioned with a Service of Dedication at St Mary's Colac in November 2011 and in January 2012 we welcomed our first guests for "home-like" respite and palliative care.

On 7 March 2022 a Service of Re-dedication was held at St Mary's Colac as we celebrated 10 years of hospice care for Colac and South West Victoria. At this Celebration we reviewed our ten year journey, offered prayers of thanksgiving and dedication for Anam Cara Colac, awarded some 26 Life Memberships and announced our Patron, Mr John Dowling.

We also warmly welcomed Diana Taylor, Chair of Anam Cara Geelong who told us of The New Anam Cara currently being completed at Waurn Ponds. And finally, we launched our book *"The Anam Cara Colac Story – from Vision to Reality (2004-2021)"*. Deb Payton, our inaugural Hospice Manager and Karen Eccles, our current Hospice Manager, cut our Birthday Cake and guests enjoyed social time in the Gathering Space as Anam Cara friends greeted one another and collective memories were shared.

The Anam Cara Colac journey has been, and continues to be, a journey of great community commitment and support. Our tenth year of operations is a significant milestone that also presents our governing body with the challenge of strategic planning for the next ten years!



John Dowling joined the Anam Cara Melbourne Committee in 2008 and in 2012 took over as our Chairperson, continuing in that role until that Committee went into recession in 2016. Over eight years, the Anam Cara Melbourne Committee raised some \$800,000 for our Foundation Fund, connecting us to numerous philanthropic trusts and supporters.

Significantly, when the work of our Melbourne Committee was complete, John Dowling kept quietly working on our behalf. At John's recommendation, Anam Cara Colac was connected to JB Were Melbourne who now managed the Anam Cara Colac Foundation Fund. John has connected us to a number of Trusts who have provided substantial funding to Anam Cara Colac.

In summary, John has shown both loyalty and commitment to Colac's community hospice over the past 13 years and that commitment continues to this day. The Committee of Management therefore honour John Kenneth Dowling as our third Patron, in recognition of his outstanding and ongoing support to Anam Cara Colac.
